**Welcome!**

Finally the time for the third Scandinavian Shuffle is here. It's a great feeling to welcome 150 balboa dancers from 10 different countries to Göteborg!

**Airport** Those of you arriving to Göteborg by airplane, there are airport coaches (Flygbussarna) that will take you to the city centre.

**Public transport** The local public transport company is called Västtrafik. You can buy a 3 day pass for 130 SEK or a 5 trips pass for 83 SEK. Some of you with private accommodation will live in Mölndal. In that case the card is called Göteborg+ and a 3 day pass is 200 SEK and 5 trips 126 SEK. Check with your host. Other ticket options exist; check the web site for more information.

**Forum** To go to Forum where the Friday party, late night party on Saturday and the Sunday party is, take tram 10 (direction Guldheden) to Doktor Fries Torg. You can also take tram 6, 7, 8 or bus 16 to Wavrinskys plats. From there you can take tram 10 one stop or a 10 minutes walk.

**Friday** Due to Swedish regulations we will not sell any alcohol on the Friday night party. If you want a beer or some wine, feel free to bring your own. If you are hungry, there is a restaurant serving pasta, salads etc and a pizzeria on Doktor Fries Torg. During the evening there will be some "fika" served. Tickets to the guided tram tour will be sold for 50 SEK, bring cash.

**Saturday** The tram tour starts at the Central Station (stop E, close to Hotell Eggers) and ends at Järntorget, where we will do a Balboa flash mob. Then we'll go to Annedalsgården (Carl Grimbergsg 52) to learn some Slängpolska, a Swedish traditional couple dance. Slängpolska was very popular on the social dancefloor in the eighteenth and nineteenth century. And today still alive! After this it's time for lunch. Feel free to join all activities or drop in and out as you please.

**Shoes** Trina from Jigwalk will come and sell shoes during the Friday and Sunday dances. Full-weekend participants gets a 100 SEK discount! (\*applies to total purchase price and does not apply on already discounted items). Just show your weekend pass at time of purchase.

**Private accommodation** Don't forget to ask your host if you need to bring sheets and towels.

## Tourist in Göteborg

**Heaven 23** (Gothia Towers) Skybar with a magnificent view of Göteborg. Try their king size shrimp sandwich or just enjoy something from the bar.

**7:an; ölhall** (Kungssportsplatsen) is from year 1900, serves beer. Only beer.

**Feskekôrka** If you want to try some local fish, why not go for lunch at Feskekôrka, an indoor fish market.

**Saluhallen** (Kungstorget) Indoor food market. The restaurant Amanda Boman is considered to have the best meat balls in town if you want to try this very Swedish dish.

**Kungssportsavenyn and Linnegatan** The two major restaurant streets in Göteborg. One is situated in the city center and the other goes from Järntorget to Linnéplatsen.

**Haga Nygata** A cozy street filled with coffeehouses, situated in Haga, and well worth a visit. Here you can go for a Swedish "fika" or a light lunch.

Among the most famous coffeehouse is Café Husaren (Haga Nygata 28) with it's enormous cinnamon buns. Café Kringlan is taking up the challenge about having the largest buns. This time of year is also the time for "Semla", another kind of bun with almond filling and whipped cream.

**Heden** Here you can rent skates and enjoy some ice skating. Saturday 13.15 there is a "Bandy" game at Heden. Entrance 100 SEK (students 50 SEK).

**Röhsska** Museum of Fashion, Design and Decorative Arts

**Götaplatsen** Place for the Art museum, Concert hall & Statue of Poseidon

**Kronhuset and Kronhusbodarna** The oldest building in Göteborg, from 1642. Here you can also find a cosy café where you can have lunch or coffee

**More lunch places** Sjöbaren (Fish, Haga Nygata 25), En Deli Haga (Haga Nygata 15), Solrosen (Veg, Kaponjergatan 4), Saluhallen Briggen (Nordhemsgatan), Vino pasta (Plantagegatan), Bombay (Indian, A.Långg 2)

## Swedish dictionary

Coming to Sweden, there is one word you need to learn and that is "fika". Fika is both a Swedish verb and noun that roughly means "to drink coffee," usually accompanied by something sweet. But fika is more than that, it's a social event with chats, gossip and discussion. Make sure not to miss out on this.
